Webinar on 'Application Design Methodologies' by Microsoft and AAU

The College of Engineering and Information Technology at AAU, Al Ain Campus, organized, in collaboration with Microsoft, USA, a webinar entitled “Application Design Methodologies – as practiced by Microsoft Globally”. The webinar was conducted simultaneously from the USA as well as at AAU, Al Ain campus. According to the Microsoft report, this is considered the first initiative of its kind on university level.

Dr. Hasan Wahbeh, Dean of the College of Engineering and Information Technology, welcomed Mr. Naveed Ahmed, Senior Software Development Engineer at Microsoft, USA. Dr. Wahbeh referred to Mr. Naveed’s contributions in delivering widely used Microsoft products, Microsoft
